McNab secures Masters Toowoomba

Home improvement shoppers will have a new paradise soon with the announcement of the latest development for McNab – Masters Toowoomba.

The highly anticipated development is currently hot topic with a lot of interest surrounding the store's potential location in the Garden City.

The 13,000m², development and construction project is set to be built at the southern end of Hume Street, a couple of doors down from another McNab development, The Ridge Shopping Centre.

The Toowoomba store will inject new life into the local economy with the project predicted to have up to 100 workers on-site during construction and create around 130 jobs once complete.

Masters Toowoomba, worth approximately \$25 million, and will be the second Masters project for McNab, with the company recently completing the Springfield store - the first to open in Queensland and the second in Australia.

McNab CEO Mark Adamson said the company's strong record in, safety, quality and innovation contributed to their success.

"Masters Toowoomba will provide a new retail choice for home improvement shoppers and we're really proud to be a part of a project that will sustain the growth of the region," Mr Adamson said.

"We've been working collaboratively with Toowoomba Regional Council to ensure the viability of this project and this has enabled us to hit the ground running."

"Our staff have a strong focus on continual improvement and it's this commitment to customer service and excellence that has contributed to our success," Mr Adamson said.

Masters, a joint venture between Woolworths and US-based Lowes, is set to provide renewed competition in Darling Downs' home improvement industry with the Toowoomba store due to open in the second half of 2012.
